

What is an Energy Treasure Hunt?

Teams engage in an energy treasure hunt throughout a building - such as a school, hospital or manufacturing facility - to identify and uncover energy-saving opportunities. The goal is to locate areas where energy is wasted and to recommend measures to reduce energy consumption and costs.

Private, public, and non-profit organizations are welcome to apply. To participate, organizations must:

- be located in a rural community with a population less than 10,000
- have average power bills totaling at least \$2,000/month


On-Site Treasure Hunt & Data Collection
